

# ***Oceania Table Tennis Federation***

## ***General Regulations***

### ***TEAM or INDIVIDUAL SELECTION***

Updated 21st April 2004

The following guidelines shall apply when Oceania is invited to nominate players or teams for a specific event

- 1) Where possible, appropriate qualifying events shall be held at the last Oceania Championships staged prior to the close of entries. The winner(s) of such events shall be automatically qualified to represent Oceania. In the case of a team event it is the country winning the event which shall represent Oceania, but not necessarily the players who were in the team at the time. The country shall have the opportunity to select its best team at that time. In the case of an individual event, it is the player or pair who shall represent Oceania, not the country of that player or pair.
- 2) Where it is not possible to hold appropriate qualifying events during the Oceania Championships it is recommended that a separate qualifying tournament should be held.
- 3) If it is not possible to stage a qualifying tournament, individual players shall be determined from the most current World Ranking List at the time of close of entries for the event
- 4) Where a combined Oceania team is to be selected, a selection panel shall be formed to make the selection. Such selection panel shall consist of 3 persons, each from a different member country, one of whom shall be the Chairman of the Classification & Technical Committee, plus the OTTF Development Officer. Any appointment of officials to accompany such team shall be made by the OTTF Management Committee.
